Curriculum

As part of our curriculum, children will be having regular nurture sessions to settle, build trust and develop social and emotional skills. Our science focus we will be Animals including Humans. For our Geography, we will be studying map reading skills. Topic. We will also be studying RE (Christmas Story), Computing (Coding), Music (Livin' on a Prayer) and Art (North American Art).

For Phonics, Maths and English, children will be in personalised learning groups, meaning that they may have a different teacher to their usual teacher. In Maths we follow the Power Maths scheme of work, aligned with White Rose Maths, with NFER assessments to determine progress. Phonics will follow either Read Write Inc. Phonics or Read Write Inc. Spelling, depending on initial assessment results. English will follow National Curriculum objectives.

Our Offer

We will be using the school grounds to explore and adventure. We have a number of facilities in school that children will be able to use, such as Mountain bikes, inline skates, skateboards and Mountain boards.

The main focus of our class is to reward positive behaviour. We have a number of tools in class for this such as individual reward cards, class trips, special helper ideas and countdown charts where they can earn popcorn and a DVD!
