Physical Education

Curriculum

As part of our curriculum, children will continue to have regular nurture sessions to build friendships and develop social and emotional skills, linked to SEMH targets. We will be using the school grounds to explore and adventure, as well as getting out and about for trips as part of our nurture offer. Our science focus we will be Electricity. Topic will cover History and Geography. We will also be studying Computing (Spreadsheets), Music (Jazz), Art (The Seaside), RE (Creation Stories). For Maths and English, children will be in personalised learning groups, meaning that they may have a different teacher to myself. In Maths we continue to follow the Power Maths scheme of work, supported by White Rose Maths, with NFER assessments to determine progress.

Homework for Maths will be set on a Monday to be returned on a Tuesday. English will follow National Curriculum with a focus on either Read Write Inc. Phonics or Spelling. English homework will be set on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
