Multi-Academy Trust Re-Structure-Stakeholder Engagement Document

The Manor Hall Academy Trust and the Adelaide Academy Trust have set out an intention to merge and become the Manor Hall Academy Trust. The rationale and the benefits of the proposed changes are set out in the statement below.

The Manor Hall Academy Trust and the Adelaide Academy Trust are both Special School Multi-Academy Trusts with both Trust's supporting the sector of SEMH and Alternative provision.

Both Trusts have a shared ethos in terms of collaborative school improvement, the empowerment of leaders and the development of staff to provide the best provision and service for the children young people and families, that form their communities.

The Manor Hall Academy Trust has strong leadership and governance at all levels as documented in the most recent DfE Review, Free School and TCaF applications.

The merger of the two Trusts would strengthen the Trusts' school improvement strategy and help to continue to align school improvement, with a sustainable growth strategy and regulatory and efficient finance and business function.

A recently submitted TCaF bid in April 2020 outlines the Trust's ambitions to improve capacity by strengthening the central team, enhancing the school improvement strategy and developing MHAT practices, services, systems, processes and policies. Such ambitions, efficiently managed, will deliver the best possible education to as many children as the MHAT can reach coherent with strategic and business objectives and Key Performance Indicators.
